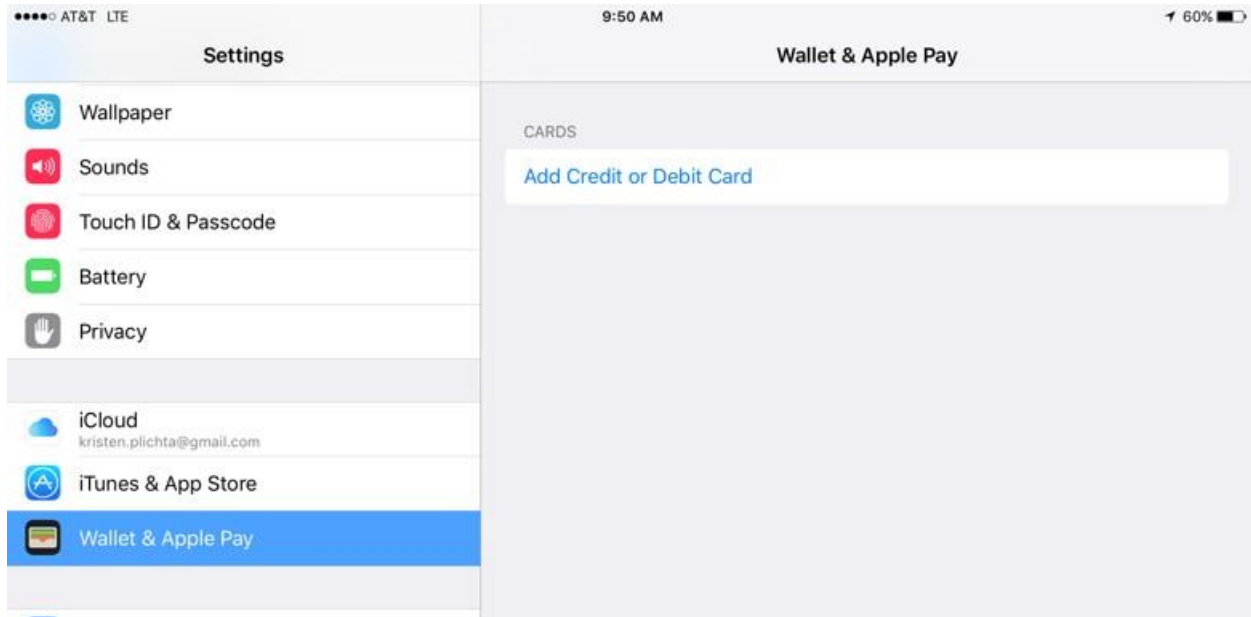
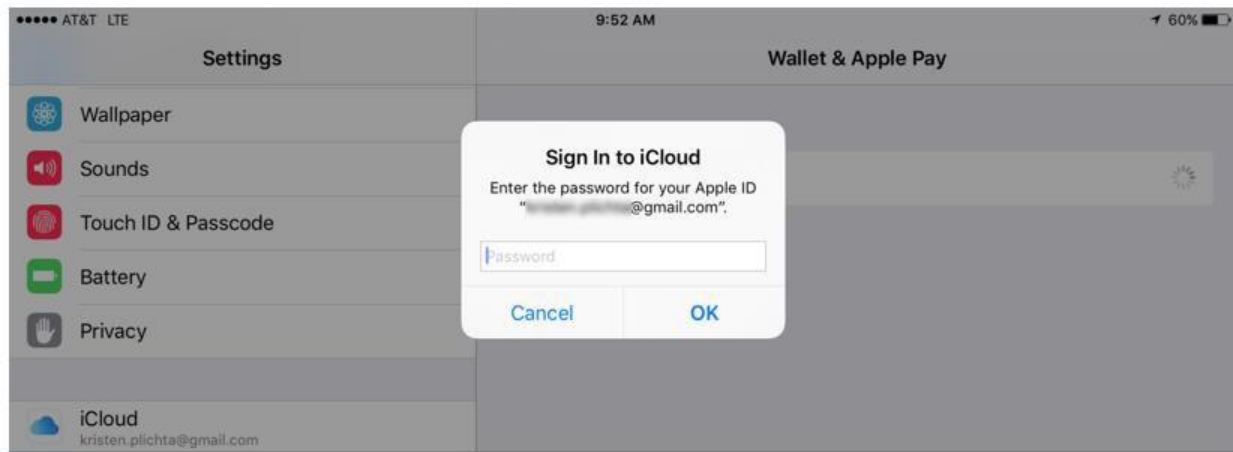


Apple Pay Step-by-Step Screen Shots

Go to Settings. Locate Apple Pay and tap Add Credit or Debit Card



Log in using your Apple ID

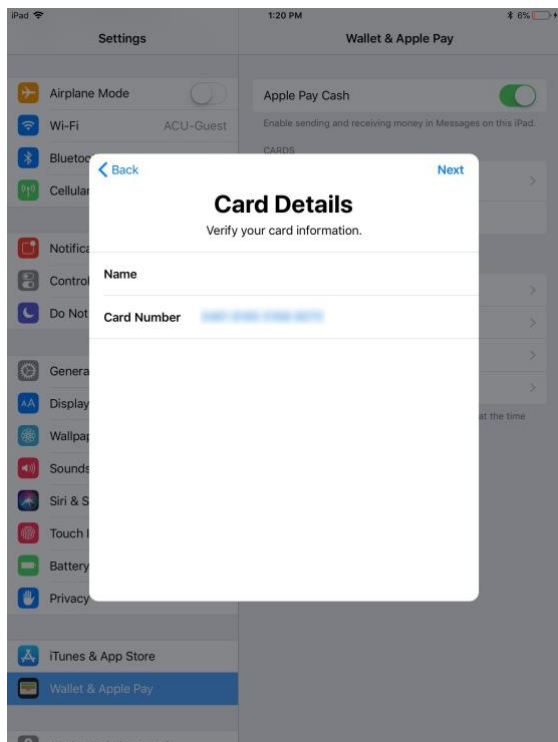


If there is a card on file with iTunes, it will be presented by default. If this is the card being added, enter the 3 digit code on the back of the card. If this is not the card, tap on Add a Different Credit or Debit Card.

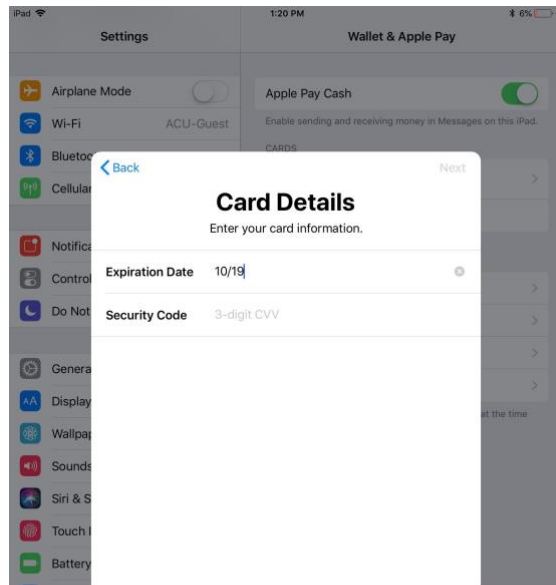


If adding a new card, you will be prompted to capture a picture. Center the card in the frame and wait. The device will take the picture automatically. If it doesn't work, you may enter the card details manually.



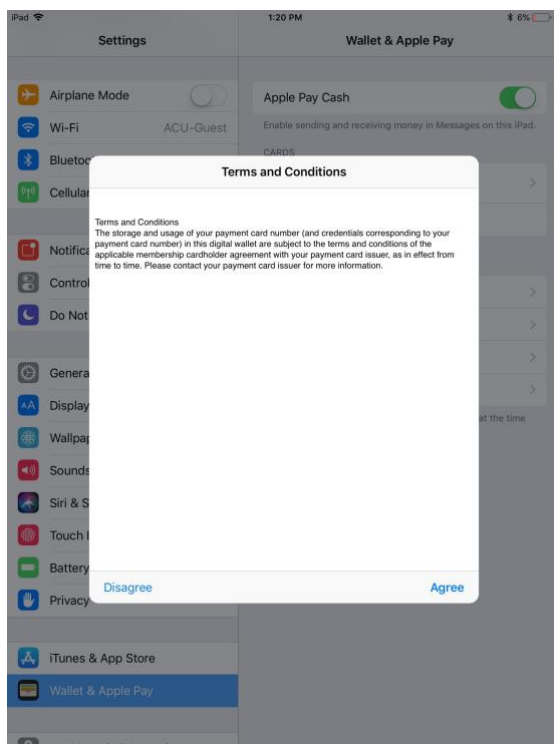


Add the name on the card then hit next.

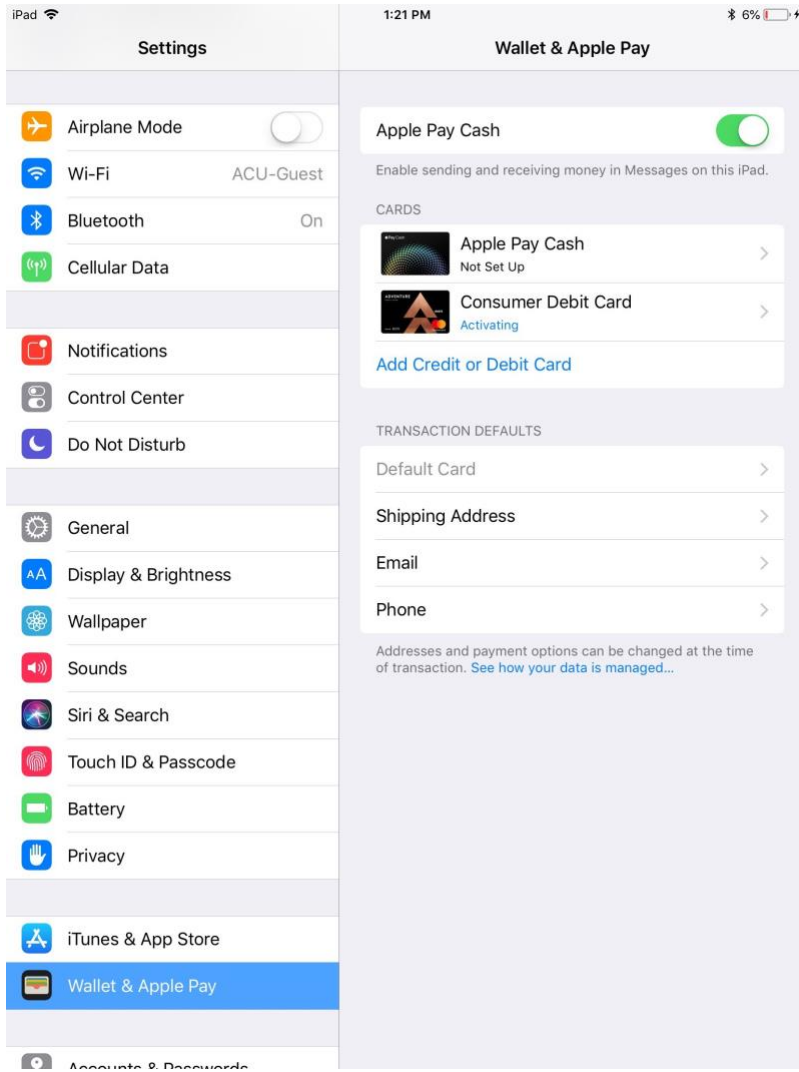


Enter the expiration date and the Security Code (3 digit code on the back of the card).

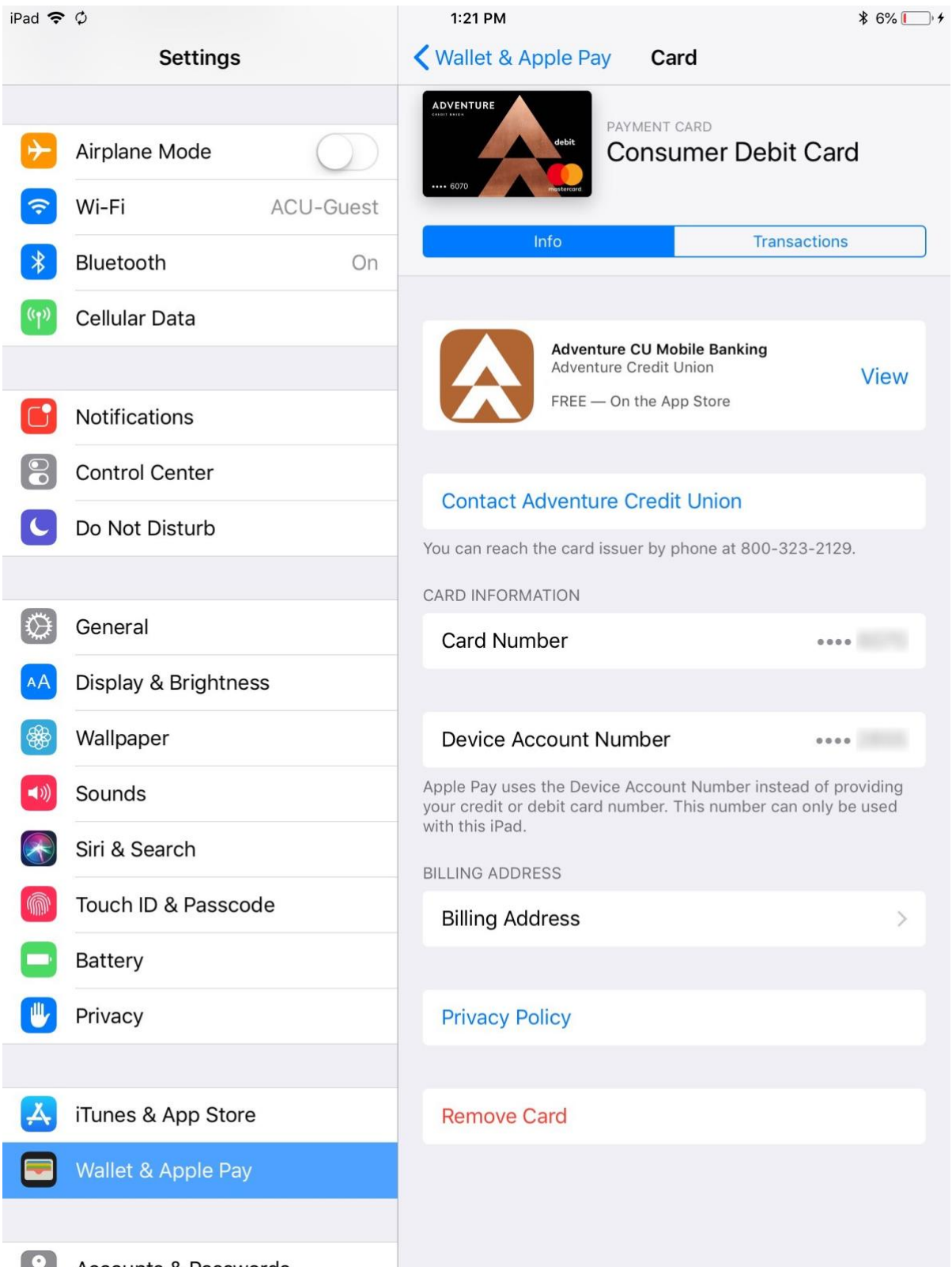
